**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

This action was commenced on May 6, 2010 with the filing of a Complaint that requested that inspection services should be withdrawn from the Respondent because of its failure to maintain sanitary conditions or operate in a manner sufficient to prevent the adulteration of meat or meat food products as required by Section 8 of the Federal Meat Inspection Act (FMIA), 21 U.S.C. §608 and the Regulations promulgated thereunder (9 C.F.R. §416 and 417).

At the request of the Respondent, the grant of inspection services as well as the authority to use labels bearing the inspection mark were withdrawn from the Respondent effective August 20, 2010. Based upon all of the circumstances, the Agency has determined that no further action need be taken at this time and has requested that this action be dismissed without prejudice.

Being sufficiently advised, it is **ORDERED** that this action be **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
