

# Instructions - Viewing Closed Caption using the Various Media Players

## Displaying Closed Captions on Windows Media Player:

Start by: Right-clicking along the top in order to display the "Menu" to adjust settings under both "Tools" and "Play" options.

1. Go to **Tools > Options > Security** (and check the box for **Show Local Captions when Present**)
2. Go to **Play > Lyrics, Captions and Subtitles** (and select **On if Available**)

## Displaying Closed Captions on iTunes:

1. Go to top menu **Edit > Preferences** (and select the playback icon).
2. In the bottom of that window select **Show closed captions when available**.

## Displaying Closed Captioning on RealPlayer:

1. Go to Menu bar and select **Tools > Preferences > Content**
2. Select **Preferences** from the Tools menu (the General preferences menu will appear).
3. Select **Content** from the category window.
4. Near the bottom right is the **Accessibility** option.
5. Select the **Use supplemental text captioning when available** option.
6. Click **OK** and **restart the clip** by clicking "**Stop**" then "**Play**."
